(CCC) UK Gov Annual Accounts

From the UK Gov Annual Accounts I have found that the Government gives the regions a large amount of money annually. How much income does Cambridge City Council get from the East of England Regional Fund? Please break this down as follows: 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23. This includes monies which are ring-fenced and may include monies coming via Cambridgeshire County Council/the unitary authority or by other means.

Response

During the years requested, Cambridge City Council has not received income from the East of England Regional Fund.

The Council has however received funds under the Cambridge and Peterborough Devolution Deal to support the delivery of an affordable housing programme. Under this Devolution Deal, the council received £70 million across a number of financial years and split as follows:

- Pre 2018/19: £0.584 million
- 2018/19: £13.552 million
- 2019/20: £26.885 million
- 2020/21: £28.979 million.
