Adoption Statement for the Old Press/Mill Lane Supplementary Planning Document (Regulation 16 (2) and 19 of Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004) as amended

Cambridge City Council has adopted the Old Press/Mill Lane Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) with effect from 12 January 2010. Any person aggrieved by the Old Press/Mill Lane SPD may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.

Title of Document: Old Press/Mill Lane SPD.

Subject Matter: The Old Press/Mill Lane SPD sets out the City Council's aspirations for the future use and development of a site situated in the historic core of Cambridge.

Area of Document: The SPD applies to a site set in the historic core of Cambridge bounded by Silver Street to the north, Trumpington Street to the east, Little St Mary's Lane to the south and Granta Place and the Mill Pit to the west.
