## Adoption Statement for the Planning Obligations Strategy Supplementary Planning Document (Regulation 16 (2) and 19 of Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004) as amended

Cambridge City Council has adopted the Planning Obligations Strategy Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) with effect from 16 March 2010. Any person aggrieved by the Planning Obligations Strategy SPD may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.

Title of Document: Planning Obligations Strategy SPD.

**Subject Matter:** The Planning Obligations Strategy SPD provides a framework for securing the provision of new and/or improvements to existing infrastructure generated by the demands of new development. It also seeks to mitigate the adverse impacts of development and addresses the needs identified to accommodate the projected growth of Cambridge.

Area of Document: The SPD applies to the whole administrative area of Cambridge.
