Top tips:

- Put a **bag** or a **bin** in your bathroom **just for recycling**
- Remember to recycle **baby products** and **men's toiletries** too
- Remember to remove and put **trigger spray** and **pump dispenser tops** in your blue bin
- **Toothpaste boxes** can be recycled but not the tubes

You can now **RECYCLE** all of these items from your **KITCHEN**

Top tips:

- **Squash cans** and **bottles** and **flatten boxes** to save space in your blue bin
- **Rinse** your plastic bottles, food containers, trays and cartons in your **old washing-up water**
- Recycle your **plastic bags, film** and **food wrappers** in your blue bin too
- You can recycle **glass jars** as well

You can now **RECYCLE** all of these items from your **LOUNGE**

Top tips:

- Recycle **all** the **newspapers** and **envelopes** from your living room in your blue bin
- **Cardboard packing** from your online orders can also be recycled
- You can recycle other items such as electricals or textiles using the **public recycling points** across the city or **recycling centres at Thriplow and Milton**
- Please make sure all your recycling is in the blue bin with the lid closed
