

New Driver Knowledge Test Registration Form



To commence the new driver application process, you must first register to take the Cambridge City Council Knowledge Test (KT). Only once you have passed all elements may you continue with the application process.

This registration form is for the application of a DUAL driver licence, this is the most flexible type as it means you are able to drive both Hackney Carriage and Private Hire vehicles. Please note there is difference to the test or procedures. If you would like to apply only for a Private Hire or Hackney Carriage Driver licence, please contact taxi@cambridge.gov.uk

To become a licensed driver with Cambridge City it is essential that you are able to meet/ comply and action the following criteria, there are no exceptions:

You must have been authorized to drive a car in the UK (e.g. held a full driving licence issued by a state in the European Economic Area) for a minimum of two years and hold a current DVLA UK photo card style driver's licence.	
You must provide evidence of the right to live and work in the UK. If you are not a UK or EEA national, then you will need to ensure that any documentation detailing your permanent or temporary right to live and work in the UK is presented at your application appointment.	
You need to understand that unless there are exceptional circumstances it is unlikely that an individual will be granted a licence if they fall under the City Council's enforcement management system (as detailed in Cambridge City Council's Hackney carriage and private hire handbook).	
You must have completed the Taxi Safeguarding & Disability Awareness Training provided by STC. You must provide a copy of the certificate at the same time that you complete the test registration form. A link to the training can be found here: Taxi Safeguarding & Disability Awareness Training STC Safeguarding children training and consultancy Northamptonshire Child exploitation Taxi/hotel safeguarding training	
You must have read and understood the required guidance notes within the Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licensing Handbook https://www.cambridge.gov.uk/taxi-licensing-policy-and-handbook	
You must provide an email address so that we can correspond with you.	
You must pay the appropriate fees for attending the Knowledge Test. Once you have paid the fees you must provide details of the payment made including the receipt(s) number and date of payment. This registration form, safeguarding certificate and receipt must be submitted together. Your registration will not be processed if we receive these separately.
