

Community Coordinator (Youth) Role

Support community groups, organisations and in some cases individuals to develop youth focused projects in the following ways

- Funding - Either internal or external
- Training – For staff and volunteers, either in house or through external agencies
- Policy development – Youth Club in a box tool
- Mentoring and advice where appropriate
- Linking up organisations to work in partnership – Youth Forum

Youth Work approaches to ASB

Generic provision

- Open access youth groups/clubs
- Activity based projects, Art, sport, media.
- Participation or work around young people's voice.
- CCY role to support this where possible

Targeted interventions

- Where specific young people have been identified and linked to ASB.
- Focused group work – Transforming Lives
- Early Help Assessment for YPW 121 support – Holistic approach.
- Detached/outreach projects to ASB hotspots
- Partnership work with ASB team, Police, Education community youth providers. – Libraries example. Training, signposting, focused work with families.
