

# Environment Act 1995 Part IV Section 83(1)

## Cambridge City Council

### Air Quality Management Area (AQMA) Order

Cambridge City Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following order.

This order may be cited as the **Cambridge City Council Air Quality Management Area 2004**, and shall come into effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2004.

The area shown on the attached map in red is to be designated as an air quality management area (the designated area). The designated area incorporates the Cambridge inner ring road and the land within it; junctions with main feeder roads and the inner ring road and a buffer around these areas defined by existing geographic features.

The Map may be viewed at the Council Offices.

This area is designated in relation to a likely breach of the nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations (England) 2000 (as amended 2002).

This Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order.

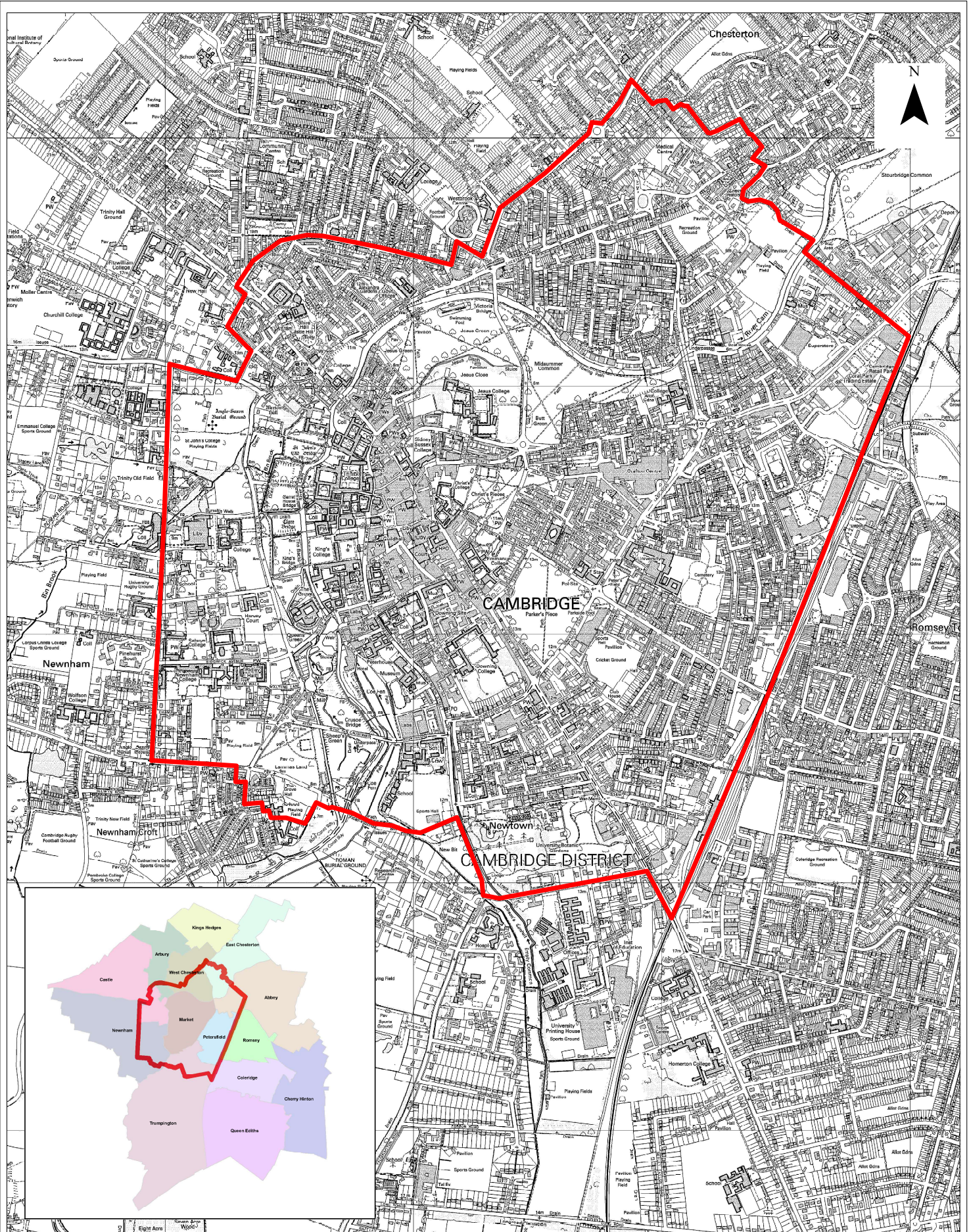
